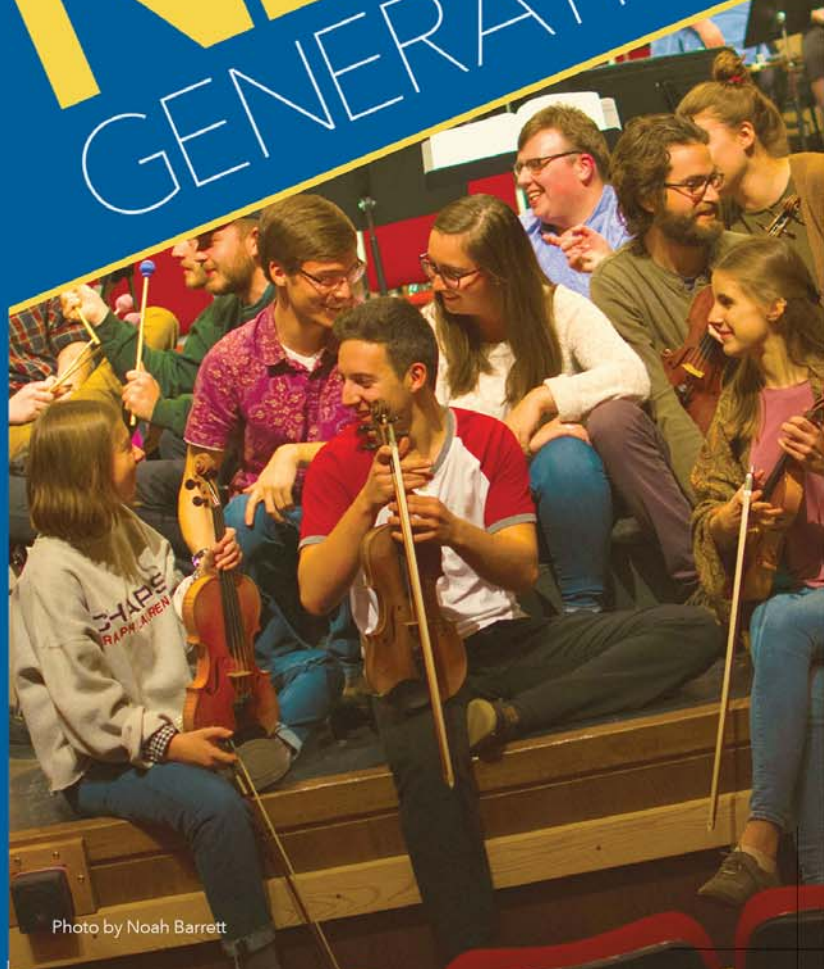

## NSO by the numbers

- \$4/5** Donor support is vital. Four out of every five dollars of the NSO's annual revenue comes from our community...local businesses and people like you.
- 3/4** Three quarters of the NSO's annual expenditures go directly into what matters most - our musicians - who bring their beautiful music to concert stages, special events and schools throughout Newfoundland & Labrador
- 80+** At over 80 members strong, the Newfoundland Symphony Orchestra is by far the largest employer of musicians in the province.
- 1/3** One-third of our orchestra members teach privately in the community, forming a solid and high quality core for private instrumental instruction. This results in nearly 15,000 hours of teaching per year.
- 20** The NSO will perform nearly 20 times during the 2017/18 season for nearly 20,000 Newfoundlanders and Labradorians, many of them young music lovers.
