



WILDFLOWERS: Celebrating the Women of Country



#### David Gilbert Smith March 21, 1948 - January 14, 2022

Tonight, as we celebrate another wonderful Big Band concert, the Newfoundland Symphony Orchestra would like to recognize the passing this past January of David Smith.

David was a consummate musician, and a fixture across the local community as both a participant and leader in musical groups, bands and indeed the NSO. He was a long-time member of the Ed Goff Big Band and the Jim Duff Big Band and performed regularly as alto saxophonist for NSO Big Band Concerts dating back to the early days of the Big Band Shows at Arts & Culture Centre.

He was also a member of the Atlantic Saxophone Quartet, the founding Director of Jazz East, and the director of the O'Donel Jazz Band that, in 1987, won the Most Outstanding Band Award at MusicFest Canada.

David was also Director of the Rotary Jazz Band, both a clinician and member of the organizing committee for Rotary Music Festival, conducted the CLB Band and Royal Newfoundland Regiment Band, and over the years was a part of countless groups performing regularly for weddings, dances at the Old Colony Club and conventions.

David's connection to this concert and the NSO will certainly live on through both the impact he has had on our Big Band traditions, and the presence of his daughter Sarah Comerford, a long-time member of the NSO's flute section.

## GUEST ARTISTS



Mallory Johnson has been turning heads in the country music scene and songwriting community, sharing stages with artists like Carolyn Dawn Johnson, Rascal Flatts, and Blake Shelton. Following her ECMA awardwinning debut EP, the 8x MusicNL nominee released a digital 45 in 2019, earning her recognition at the 2019 International Songwriting Competition, The 18th Independent Music Awards and the 19th Annual NSAI Song Contest. Most recently, Mallory collaborated with West Coast duo Twin Kennedy on a song called "Wise Woman," which received praise from publications like The East, The Bluegrass Situation and Billboard: "[A] gorgeous tale of vulnerability that strikes just the right chord" - Billboard. Coinciding with the single release, Mallory and Twin Kennedy shared a powerful music video directed by Cecil Johnson which took home Music Video of the Year at the 2021 MusicNL Awards, and is was nominated for Fan's Choice Video of the Year at the 2022 East Coast Music Awards. Mallory also won the Artist Innovator of the Year (In light of COVID-19). Last year, Mallory also co-produced and co-hosted Wise Woman - The Show, presented by The Consulate General of Canada to the Southeast United States. In honour of Women's History Month and International Women's Day, the virtual show was introduced by Kirsten Hillman, Canada's Ambassador to the United States and featured world class talent and critically acclaimed Canadian female artists residing in Nashville, TN. Wise Woman - The Show also aired as a radio special on SiriusXM Country and was nominated for the Live Innovation Award at the 2021 Canadian Country Music Awards. Mallory has been working on a new studio album in Nashville with Grammy-nominated producer Kent Wells (Dolly Parton).



**Flower HIII** is comprised of Sherry Ryan (guitar and vocals), Andrea Monro (banjo and vocals), and Maria Cherwick (fiddle and vocals).

**Sherry Ryan**'s songwriting has been winning hearts across the country and her song 'Stop The Trains'; a gem of a tune was voted best song in the province by The Overcast's 2018 People's Choice Awards. She was also awarded 2018 Music NL Female Artist of the Year.

**Andrea Monro** is a singer/songwriter and multi instrumentalist who has performed in Canada and the UK. Her performance highlights include Juno, ECMA and MusicNL showcases, performances for the CBC and The St. John's Folk Festival.

**Maria Cherwick** is a highly trained violinist and musician versed in multiple styles and traditions. Music has taken her from coast to coast and around the world as a performer of both classical and folk music. Maria was awarded 2018 and 2021 Music NL Side Musician of the Year, as well as "Celtic/Traditional Artist of the Year" in 2021. In 2020, she published "Home From Away", her first book of all original tunes for violin and viola, followed by a companion CD by the same title in 2021.



LadyLike is made up of a talented team of creative musicians and killer vocalists. Founding members Karla Pilgrim and Terri Lynn Eddy, formerly of The Secrets joined forces with Carole Besvater in January of 2021. Together they have a storied history of live performances, musical arrangements, and professional recording sessions. Karla Pilgrim's heartfelt delivery is as authentic as it gets. "Powerful, emotional, and incredibly gifted" are words that have been used to describe the vocal capabilities of Terri Lynn Eddy. Having performed together for over 20 years, Pilgrim and Eddy have travelled thousands of miles; from cross country tours, showcasing in the U.S. to playing with The Newfoundland Symphony Orchestra. Adding to their new sound is NSO's Carole Bestvater. Carole is a sought after music educator, freestyle fiddler, session player and founder of Strong Harbour Strings Program. Based in St. John's, NL, LadyLike pride themselves on their technical abilities and musical versatility, and are breaking boundaries with their new sound. They made their debut in May 2021 with a Provincial Tour of Newfoundland and Labrador. Their ground breaking new single 'Princess Charming' dropped on June 18th, 2021.



**Jenny Mallard** (Opening Act) is a singer-songwriter from Mount Pearl who has been performing professionally as a solo act and with various groups since 2016. Jenny has toured across Newfoundland four times performing country music, sharing the stage with established country musicians from our province. She has also been recognized by the East Coast Music Awards for her original songwriting, and will be releasing her first single in June, with a debut album to be released in the Fall of 2022.


