EVOLVING: The NSO truly is one of this province's most important educational, musical, and cultural resources. Our world is changing, and so is your NSO. We are working to diversify our programming, as we continue to develop top quality and imaginative concerts and events which recognize classical tradition, while also appealing to a range of audiences.

#### IN THE COMMUNITY

Our organization and our musicians are true ambassadors of music in the community. NSO players work in school music programs across the Avalon region. They also teach privately, combined more than 15,000 hours per year. Our players are part of the pit orchestras of local opera and musical theatre productions, work with local choirs, teach at MUN School of Music and work with local groups including Strong Harbour Strings and Suzuki STEP.

## PARTNERING WITH AMAZING LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS

Our arts community is a vibrant and supportive ecosystem in Newfoundland and Labrador, and the NSO values partnering with other organizations. We collaborate with organizations including MUN School of Music, CALOS, Wonderbolt Circus, Kittiwake Dance Theatre, Shallaway Youth Choir, Opera on the Avalon, Artistic Fraud and SciFi on the Rock – just to name a few.

We are also proud of our partnerships with The Rooms, GeoCentre and NL Public Libraries to deliver specialized events which reach out to new and diverse audiences.

## ENGAGING WITH YOUTH THROUGH SCHOOL-BASED PROGRAMS

The orchestra's Symphony Goes to School...and Beyond program, presented by Chevron, continues to have a huge impact on students across the province. The NSO undertakes an exciting array of activities as part of this program including in-school visits, live streams, a rich online repository of educational materials for daily and continuous use in school classrooms and music studios. The orchestra also presents several marquee events each season including our Sing-In/Play-In which sees over 300 students rehearse and perform with NSO musicians under the direction of Marc David. We also welcome schools to our performances to perform as part of our Prelude Concerts. Also together with the Department of Education, the NSO presents the Fine Art Fridays program, which brings NSO performances and presentations to classrooms across the province. This past season we reached over 10,000 students through these programs.

## CONNECTING WITH DIVERSE POPULATIONS IN OUR COMMUNITY

Our concerts now entertain and provide joy to people far beyond the walls of our concert halls. Through the NSO Everywhere Outreach Program individuals who do not have the socio-economic means or who are isolated due to residency in a seniors or group home setting are able to watch NSO concerts online, free of charge. Over 80 seniors/retirement homes across the province have made these concerts part of their programs. In addition, our concerts and programs, for example our Sensory Friendly Concerts, are used by health and wellness service organizations including L'Arche families, Easter Seals, Autism Society, Special Olympics, Gathering Place, and Stella's Circle as part of their social and music therapy programs. We know from feedback how valuable these concerts and programs are to youth and community members' well being.
